### Rules

#### **Ski Joring Races: Junior; Open; Women's**

1. The ski joring races will have 2 go-rounds of which the times will be combined.

2. The course will have a minimum of 12 gates and 3 jumps. Skier must go right of red and left of blue gates.

3. Horse and/or rider can only enter twice regardless of race division or combinations thereof. **Skier can enter twice, but must be with different horse & rider.** Skier cannot be a rider on another team.

4. Time starts and stops when the skier crosses the line.

5. The skier must be in an upright position and on at least one ski when crossing the finish line.

6. There is a five second penalty for each gate or jump missed. Both tips of the skis must go around the gate, otherwise it is considered missed.

7. If the horse hits a gate, the gate is missed.

8. If the skier loses the rope, the team is disqualified for that gate round.

9. If the rider, or the skier or horse is unable to complete their second run, they may not find a replacement. They are disqualified.

10. Written parental consent is required for participants under 18 years of age. Parent must be present at registration.

11. No participants will be allowed in the arena during the designing of the course. No horses will be allowed in the arena prior to race time.

12. Rope length shall not exceed 50 feet.

13. A designated veterinarian can disqualify a horse.  
**The decision of the Judges is Final.**

#### **Longest Jump**

1. Distance will be measured at foot of impact.

2. Jumper must land and maintain control.

3. Jumper must be 17 years or older.
